



ATTENDEE TERMS & CONDITIONS

Any person, delegate, student, media representative, speaker, sponsor, exhibitor or any individual accompanying any of the foregoing (“Attendee”) who is present at the North American Society for Trenchless Technology’s No-Dig Show (the “Show”) automatically agrees to abide by the terms and conditions set forth below (“Attendee Conditions”), and the decisions and interpretations on North American Society for Trenchless Technology and its agents (collectively “NASTT”) , which shall be final and binding in all matters relating to the Show and Attendee’s attendance at same. These Attendee Conditions apply to every Attendee regardless of whether they have received a formal registration.

NASTT reserves the right to render, in its sole discretion, all interpretations and decisions in connection with the Attendee Conditions and to establish further terms and conditions binding upon the Attendee as may be deemed necessary for the general success and wellbeing of the Show and/or any person(s) affiliated therewith.

NASTT Members.

If your NASTT Individual membership or the group Corporate/Government/Education membership of your employer has lapsed, or will expire prior to 4/10/2022, you will be required to renew to be eligible to register for the Show as a member. Renew today.

NASTT Non-Members.

Non-Member Full Show registration (only) includes a free NASTT Individual membership that begins shortly after the Show and expires on 12/31/2022. For a full year’s membership and to save \$275 USD on the Full Show registration rate, join NASTT today.

Other Non-Member registration options do not include NASTT membership. However, when you join NASTT, you will enjoy member pricing and save \$150 USD on one-day conference registration rates.

Early Discount Options.

All registrations received by March 1, 2022 qualify for the Early Discount Rates listed in the chart at nodigshow.com. Your payment must be received by March 1, 2022 to receive the Early Discount Rates. After March 1, 2022, all unpaid early registrations will be converted from the discount to the regular rate and sent confirmation emails showing the increase in fees due.

Additional Options & Events.

Pre & post Show seminars and ticketed networking events are additional options for attendees and are not included in a regular Show registration. You must register for a regular Show option (Full Show, One-Day Show or 3-Day Exhibit Hall) to add a pre and/or post Show specialized seminar or ticketed events.

Cancellation Policy.

Any cancellations must be submitted in writing by March 1, 2022 for an 75% refund. No refunds will be issued after March 1, 2022. Personnel can be substituted at any time. In the event that the Show cannot be held or is postponed due to events beyond the control of the NASTT, NASTT shall not be liable to the Attendee for any damages, costs, or losses incurred, such as transportation costs, accommodations costs, or financial losses. NASTT reserves the right to refuse entry to registrants who do not successfully comply and adhere to Attendee Conditions or any other conditions such as fire, safety and health regulations of the local, city, state, provincial in place at the time of the Show. Notification of such requirements will be made on an individual or company basis and publicly.

Rules, Regulations, & Attendee Conduct.

Attendee agrees to abide by all fire, safety, and health regulations of the local, city, state, provincial, hotels, and convention centers where the Show is held. Attendee must comply with all applicable federal, state, provincial, and local ordinances, as well as NASTT's policies and procedures, including the Services and Policies, as set forth below. Attendees who violate such rules and/or who behave in an unsafe or careless manner while attending the Show may be asked to leave immediately and will be held responsible for their actions. Attendee acknowledges that such violations may result in the Attendee being removed from the Show and barred from returning without refund of the Attendee's registration fee. Attendee likewise acknowledges and agrees that all Attendees have the right to enjoy the Show equally. Illegal or disruptive behavior that interferes with the conduct of reasonable business at the Show, or any other Attendee's safety or comfort, including behavior that impedes or prevents accessibility services or requests, behavior that discriminates based on age, disability, race, ethnicity, gender, religion, political or institutional affiliation, or sexual orientation, and harassment of any kind, is strictly prohibited and may result in Attendee being removed from the Show and barred from returning without refund of the Attendee's registration fee. Such violations may be reported to the appropriate authorities. If you witness a crime or have an emergency that requires the police, please call 911.

Content Advisory.

Attendee understands that some Show events may contain adult language and/or discuss mature themes. This content may not be suitable for all Attendees. The views and opinions expressed at the Show may not necessarily reflect the views of NASTT, its staff, Board of Directors, or members.

Limitation of Warranty.

NASTT AND ITS AGENTS PROVIDE ALL GOODS AND SERVICES RELATED TO THE SHOW, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION, THE EXHIBIT AREA, THE CONFERENCE FACILITY AND ANY EQUIPMENT "AS IS" WITH NO REPRESENTATIONS, WARRANTIES, COVENANTS, CONDITIONS OR GUARANTEES OF ANY KIND WHETHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, STATUTORY OR OTHERWISE. NASTT AND ITS AGENTS SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIM ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS OR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, TITLE, OR NON-INFRINGEMENT, TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW.

In no event shall NASTT, Show Sponsor(s), the owners of the hotel(s) and conference center where the Show is being held, their respective agents, employees, contractors, members, officers, directors and representatives ("Released Parties"), be liable for any consequential, special or incidental damages, or contingent liabilities including, without limitation, lost profits or goodwill, whether arising in tort, contract, under statute or under other law, rule or regulation. No agent or representative of NASTT or any other party has authority to offer or provide any further warranty or relief. The entire liability of the Released Parties shall be limited to the amount paid to NASTT.

Indemnity.

To the extent permitted by law, the Attendee agrees to protect, indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless the Released Parties against all claims, losses, demands, damages to persons or property, governmental charges or fines, and costs (including reasonable attorney's fees) arising out of or connected to Attendee's actions or failure to act, including violation of the Attendee Conditions or any applicable law, rule, or regulation by the Attendee, its employees, officers, directors, or agents.

Lost Registration Badge.

Attendee's registration badge must be worn and visible at all times during the Show. Access to the Show Facility will not be granted without it. If an Attendee loses, misplaces, or forgets his or her registration badge, a replacement fee of \$25.00 USD will be charged to create a new one. Once the new registration badge is released to the Attendee, the lost registration badge will become invalid.

Modification of the Show Program.

NASTT reserves the right to modify the Show program, which is published as an indication only.

Registration, Hotel, & Travel Accommodations.

Registration grants admission to the Show namely, all meetings, panels, readings, and public receptions. Meals, hotel accommodations, and travel are not included with the Show registration. Hotel accommodations are subject to availability and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Salvatory Clause.

If there is a determination that any part of the Attendee Conditions is ineffective or impracticable, then the validity of the Attendee Conditions remaining is not impaired.

Photograph and Video Usage Permission.

By registering for or attending the Show, Attendee hereby agrees to allow NASTT to use Attendee's name, image, and likeness, in whole or in part, in perpetuity, in any manner or media whatsoever (including photographs, videos, and other recordings) throughout the world, including, without limitation, in Show related publications, on NASTT websites, or in other NASTT materials, or to refrain from doing so. You hereby agree that you have no right of approval, no claim to compensation or benefit wherever lawful, and no claim, including, without limitation, claims based upon invasion of privacy, defamation, right of publicity, blurring, distortion, alteration, optical illusion, or use in composite form, whether or not intentional, arising out of any photograph or use set forth above, and NASTT shall own the materials arising out of any such photograph and use.

Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability.

Attendee assumes all risks and accepts sole responsibility for any injury (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability or expense, of any kind, that Attendee may experience or incur in connection with attending the Show. Attendee hereby releases, covenants not to sue, discharges and holds harmless the Released Parties of and from any such claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto.

COVID-19:

Specifically relating to the global COVID-19 pandemic, Attendee acknowledges the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assumes the risk of exposure or infection by attending the event, and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability and death. Attendee understands that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the event may result from the actions, omissions or negligence of others who may attend the event or their families, colleagues, or others with whom they may have contact. Accordingly, Attendee understands and agrees that this release includes any claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of NASTT, its employees, agents and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during or after participation in the event.

In addition to all other rules and regulations relating to the Attendee's attendance at the event, the Attendee agrees to comply with all other procedures that may be implemented by NASTT, in order to protect as much as possible the health and safety of all attendees. NASTT reserves the right to refuse entry to registrants who do not successfully comply and adhere to local or federal health protocol requirements in place at the time of the Show. Notification of such requirements will be made on an individual or company basis and publicly.
